- Foreign Sovereigns
- Members of Reigning Foreign Families
- Heads of State
- Governor Generals of Commonwealth Countries

Royal (Vice-Regal) Salute

(Mallorca / O' Canada)

- Governor General of Canada
- Lieutenant Governor of a Canadian Province


General Salute

- Distinguished Persons




