1 / 18	Glossary	G-6	The term "zeroing" has been modify to "sighting", and all the references will be updated throughout the rulebook.
2 / 18	1 - General	4-2	Add: "If in doubt, guidance shall be sought from the Regional Marksmanship OPI prior to the competition"
3 / 18	6.3	4-11	Modified to: "All marksmanship clothing must be made of soft flexible and pliable material that does not become stiffer, thicker or harder under commonly accepted shooting conditions. The use of adhesives or other materials on equipment, which provides an advantage to a Competitor, is prohibited. A cast or non-flexible brace on any part of the body may constitute artificial support. To request consideration for a Competitor to participate in Stage 2, 3 or 4 of the CCOMCS while wearing a cast or non-flexible brace, details of the injury or condition (including a photograph of the cast or non-flexible brace) shall be provided to the Regional Marksmanship OPI NLT one (1) week in advance of the competition. After consultation and clearance by the RCMLO, the OPI may provide approval to compete."
4 / 18	5.3.2f	4-9	Modified to: "installing an approved adjustable butt plate (Rule 6.3.9). The butt plate can be adjusted IAW Rule 6.3.9."
5 / 18	6.3.9	4-13	Should be read: "The use of an adjustable butt plate is permitted. The butt plate may be adjustable up or down and the shape of the butt plate may be slightly rounded to offer some support in the shoulder. However, turning the butt plate on the horizontal axis is not permitted and only the complete butt plate (not part) may be turned on the vertical axis. The use of a hook on the butt plate that provides extra support and/or stability is prohibited. The butt plate may not be modified by the use of adhesives or other materials that will provide an advantage to the Competitor.
6 / 18	6.3.11	-	New rule: Measuring Tape: "The use of measuring Tape, either flexible or rigid, to determine foot placement while firing in the standing position is permitted. The measuring tape may not be placed under the foot while firing."
7 / 18	7.4.6.3	4-16	Should be read: "Competitors shall not obscure the monitor or any part of the screen. The whole screen must be visible to the Officials. If the Competitor or Coach does not wish to have the monitor in their field of view, they may move the screen but it must remain in clear sight for the Range Officials when viewing from behind."
8 / 18	15.3.2	4-28	Modified to add the shooting mat in the list of equipment.

9 / 18	16.1.2	4-30	Should be read: "When firing on electronic targets, the Competitor may return to zeroing from Match Mode in the event of a rifle malfunction (Rule 5.4). An additional five (5) minutes of time may be granted IAW Rule 5.4.4."
10 / 18	16.1.3	4-30	Modified to: "When firing on electronic targets, with the approval of a range official, the Competitor may request to return to Sighting Mode from Match Mode at any time. This includes the event of a suspected rifle malfunction for the purpose of diagnosing the suspected malfunction. No additional time will be permitted for these Sighting shots."
11 / 18	17.3.1 a	4-32	Modified to: "The highest score of the last ten (10) shot standing series, working backwards by 10 shot standing series, then by 10 shot prone series as many times as is required to break the tie. If the Match doesn't contain standing firing, then the highest score of the last 10 shot prone series shall be used to break the tie;"
12 / 18	17.3.1 d	4-32	Replace by: When decimal scoring is used, ties will be broken by the highest score of the last ten shot series (decimal scores) and then by comparing decimal scores on a shot-by-shot basis beginning with the last shot, then the next to last shot, etc.
13 / 18	17.3.1.1	4-32	Has been removed from the book; Rule 17.3.1 will be used in case of any tie in a Cumulative match.
14 / 18	17.3.2	4-33	Modified to: "For Team Matches, ties will be broken by totalling the results of the top four (4) Competitors of a Team and following the procedures for breaking individual ties (Rule 17.3.1). If two Competitors are tied for the lowest score in a particular Team Match, the tie will be broken by following the procedure for breaking individual ties (Rule 17.3.1) and the lowest score will be dropped. Then, the Team Match tie will be broken by following the procedure for breaking an individual tie."
15 / 18	23.7.2	4-43	Modified to: «The Jury of Appeal for Stage 4 of the CCOMCS shall be composed of a minimum of three (3) of the Regional/National Coordinators in attendance. If there are not three Regional/National Coordinators present, the Jury of Appeal shall consist of the host Region Coordinator, the Chair of the Marksmanship Rules Committee and the National Coordinator. This group shall meet via teleconference as soon as is reasonably possible to rule on any issues that may arise."
